So far, working in collaboration and cooperation with the Holy Shrine of Hazrat Abbas (A.S.) (Ataba Abbasiya), we've already served nearly 45,000 patients in just 5.5 days, with cases ranging from common ailments to critical emergencies—treated on the spot to keep pilgrims safe and able to continue their ziyaarat.

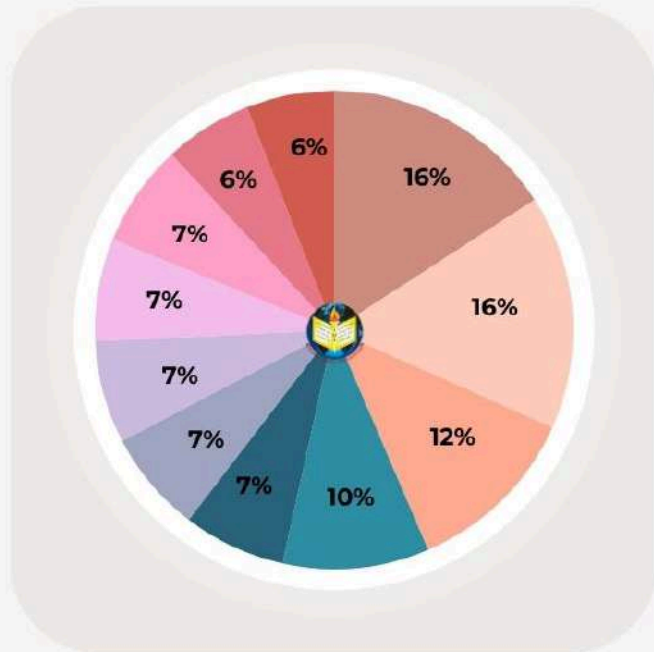

Our teams are working across multiple specialties. Here are some of the most common cases so far:

- Heat-related illnesses: Heat exhaustion & heat stroke from long walks under the sun
- Musculoskeletal injuries: Fractures, sprains, ligament tears, and chronic joint pain from extensive walking and carrying loads
- Acute infections: Upper respiratory infections, conjunctivitis, pharyngitis, cellulitis, and tooth infections
- Chronic conditions: Managing hypertension, diabetes, heart disease, and medication refills for patients who ran out mid-journey
- Wound & trauma care: Lacerations, burns, blisters, and injuries from falls—treated immediately to prevent hospital transfers
- Cardiac & neurological events: Angina, heart failure, hypertensive crises, seizures, and dehydration-related fainting



Specialist Highlights

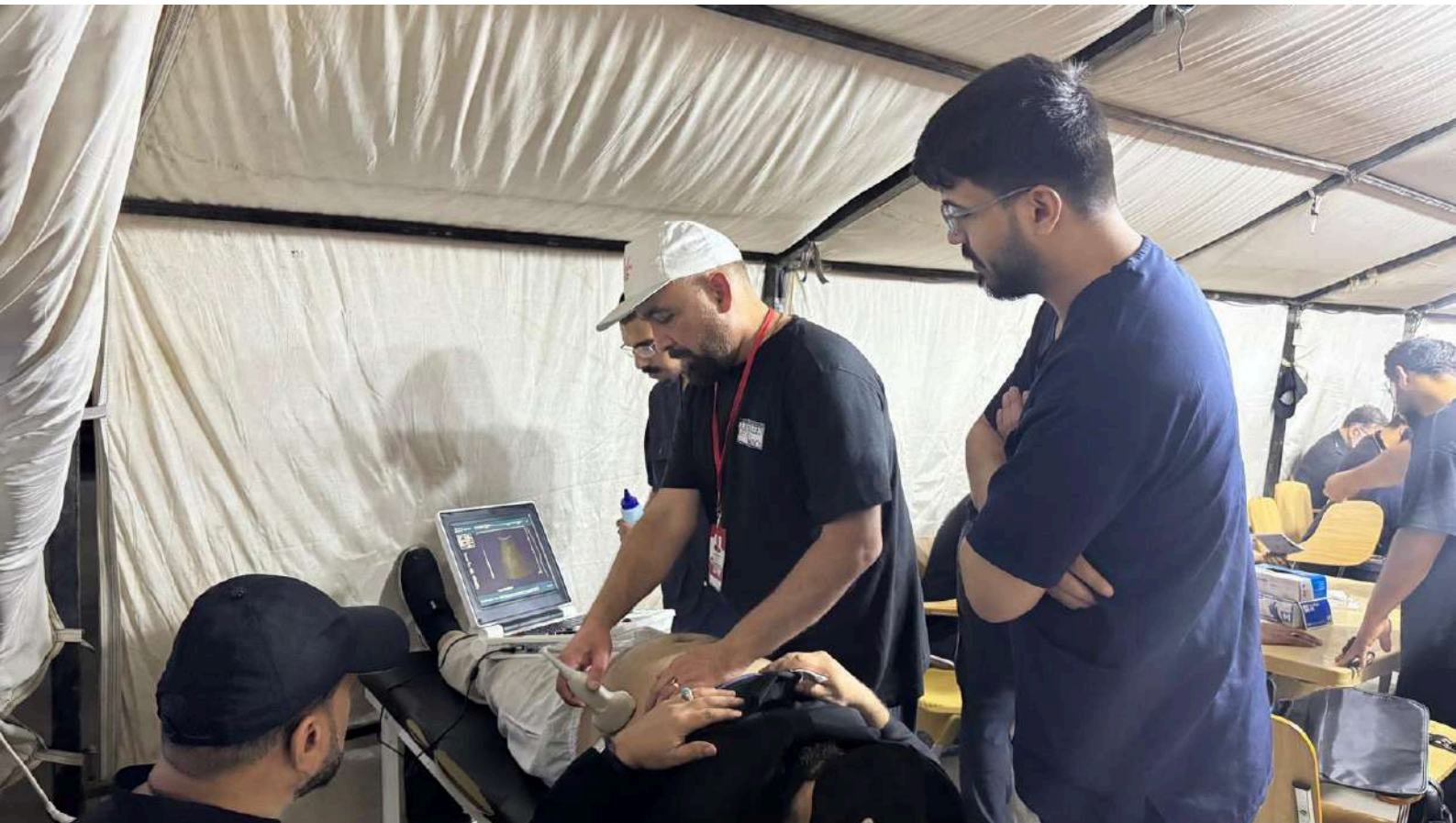
- Dermatology: Treated conditions from psoriasis and eczema to fungal infections and cutaneous tuberculosis
- Orthopedics: Managed fractures, tendon injuries, ligament ruptures, and complex lacerations
- Urology: Performed on-site ultrasounds and treated kidney stones and BPH
- Cardiology: Stabilized patients with heart failure, unstable angina, and arrhythmias
- Ophthalmology: Restored comfort and vision through cataract assessment, foreign body removal, and infection treatment



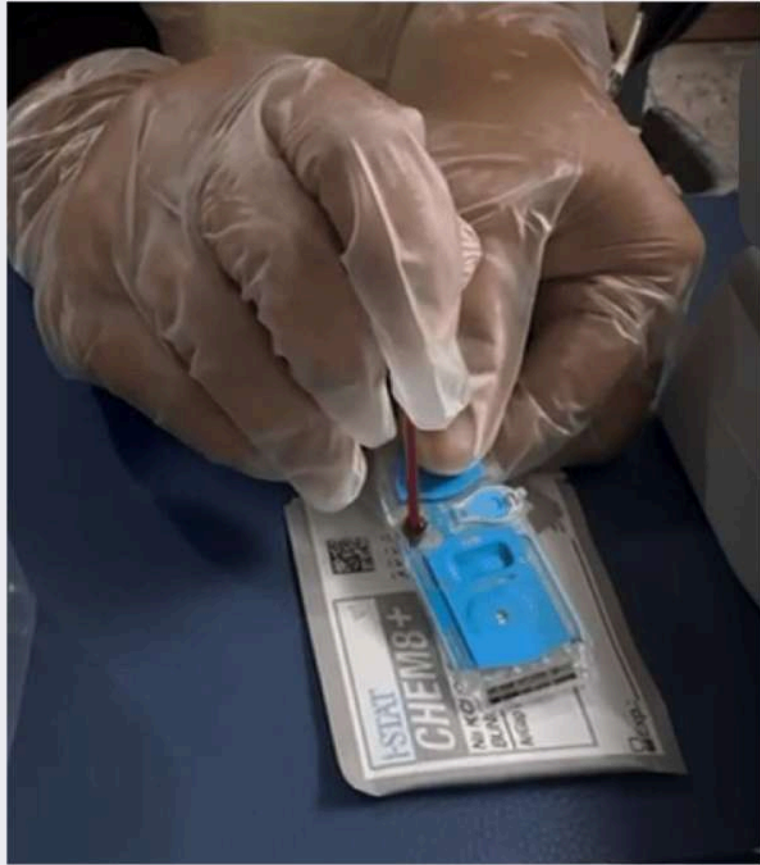
Responding to Emergencies – Every 30 Minutes

While many patients seen through the IMI Arbaeen Medical Mission in Karbala can be dealt with reasonably quickly and efficiently by the team of healthcare professionals, some issues require much deeper management and specialist expertise. Operating as an Academic Field Teaching Hospital, IMI's Arbaeen Medical Camp team quickly and deftly took care of these needs, performing tertiary level care in the field as required. Patients came in with a deep lacerations as well as with abscesses.

In addition to minor surgical procedures, our teams are currently handling two medical emergencies every hour, with numbers expected to rise as crowds peak closer to Arbaeen. The ability to treat these cases immediately—without sending patients to already overburdened hospitals—is saving lives.



Critical patients benefited with advanced care not only through our specialists but also with the use Arbaeen Medical Mission's latest equipment: the i-STAT, a portable blood analyzer that provides lab-quality diagnostic results quickly and is used for point-of-care testing in critical care situations including hospital emergency rooms.

This year a number of emergency cases were due to dehydration and heat exhaustion. A large number of critical patients with myocardial infarction, stroke, heat stroke, and acute abdomen were also successfully resuscitated and stabilized.



Extending Hours to Care for Even More **Spotlight on IMI's Dental Care**

With state-of-the-art dental chairs and equipment, IMI's Dental team worked tirelessly to cater to their never-ending patient lines each day.

The team is providing a range of services:

- Oral hygiene instructions (showing brushing and flossing techniques)
- Treating Infections
- Puss drainage
- Root Canal Treatment
- Pulpotomy
- Pulpectomy
- Extractions
- Fillings
- Scaling
- Prescribing Antibiotics and pain relief medications.



7th Annual IMI Arbaeen Conference

Running simultaneously with the medical mission, the 7th Annual IMI Arbaeen Conference is bringing together 25–40 medical and health sciences students for an intensive, hands-on learning experience. Participants are attending courses led by IMI's expert faculty covering critical topics such as:

- **BLS & Medical Triage**
- **Vital Signs: Most Common Pages**
- **Approach to Respiratory Failure**
- **Electrocardiogram (ECG) Interpretation**

- **Point-of-Care Basic Ultrasound**
- **Electrolyte Changes & Fluid Management**
- **Basics of Dermatology**
- **Principles & Practice of Medical Ethics**
- **Basic Orthopedics & X-ray Reading for Fractures**
- **Suturing Techniques – Hands-On Training**

These sessions blend clinical rotations with structured teaching to prepare the next generation of healthcare providers, reinforcing IMI's commitment to both service and education.



Clinical Rotations



In addition to the student delegates from overseas and Iraq, **200 Medical students from Warith Al Anbiyaa University and Karbala University** also received practical trainings onsite through our Arbaeen Medical camp.

Academic & Training Activities

Alongside clinical care, our academic mission is in full swing at the mini Field Teaching Hospital:

- Medical students rotating through clinical shifts daily
- 1-hour teaching sessions during rotations
- Evening academic reviews to enhance learning and skills

These students receive a lecture at the beginning of each shift and training comprising of problem-based assessment and work based assessment. They also benefited from hands-on training & mentorship from doctors as they rotate with different physicians and specialists at the camp.



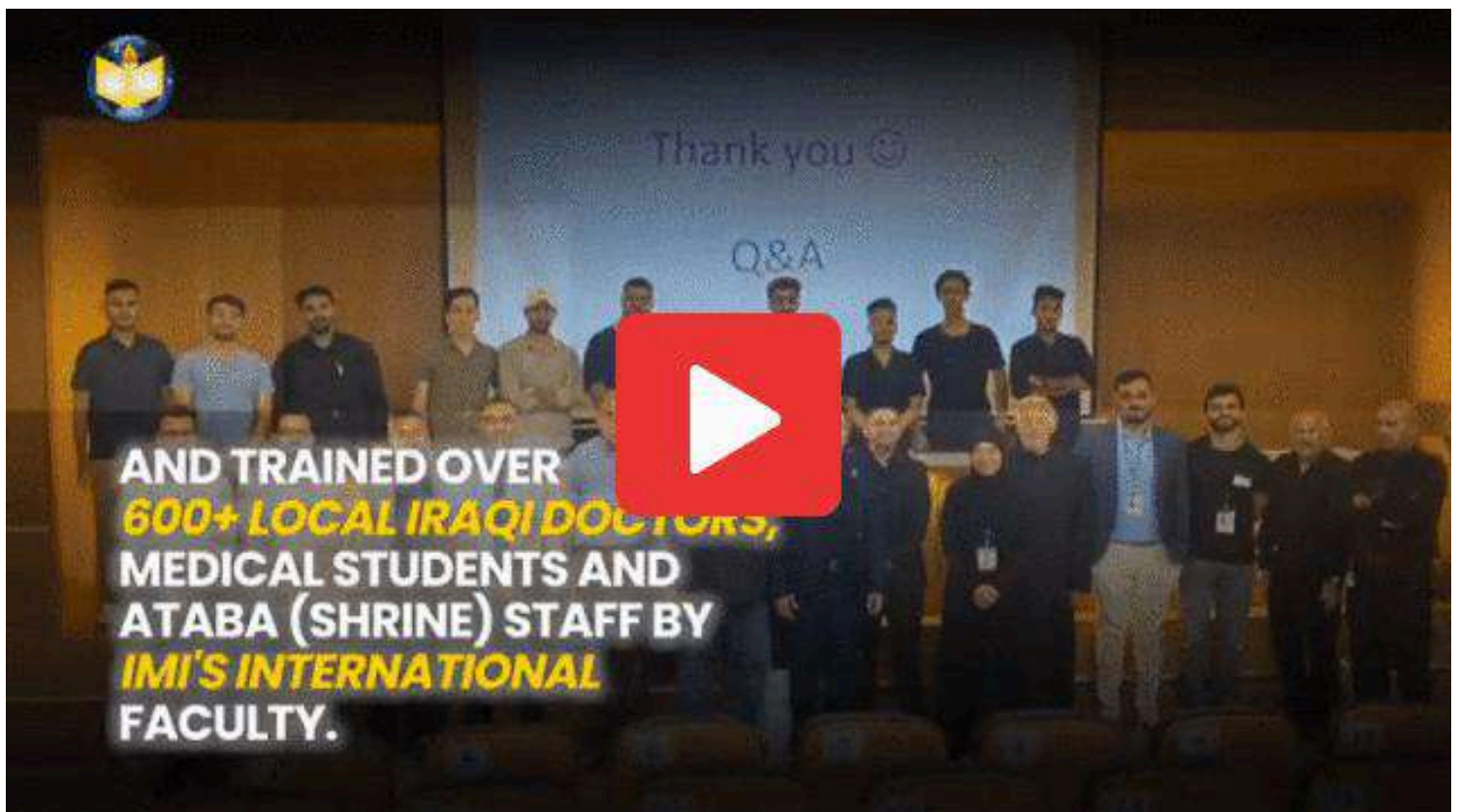

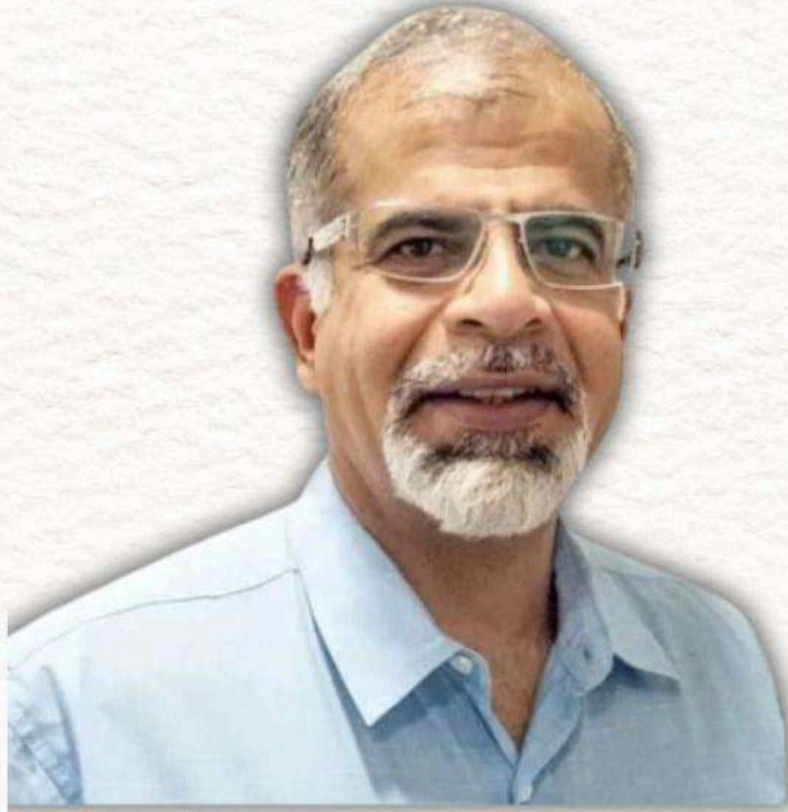
